INVITATION TO BID

RECEIPT OF BIDS

Sealed bids for the construction of the Goleta Sanitary District Wastewater Treatment Plant Upgrading project will be received by the Goleta Sanitary District represented by Mr. Kamil Azoury, General Manager/District Engineer. **Only prime contractors that have been pre-qualified by the District pursuant to Public Contract Code Section 20101 are eligible to submit a bid for this project.**

Sealed bids will be received at the Goleta Sanitary District, One William Moffett Place, Goleta, California 93117 until 2:30 pm on February 10, 2011. Bids received after the bid opening will be returned unopened. As soon thereafter as possible, the bids will be opened publicly and read aloud at the above mentioned address. Bids shall be addressed to Mr. Kamil Azoury, and shall be labeled "Goleta Sanitary District Wastewater Treatment Plant Upgrading."

GENERAL DESCRIPTION OF WORK

The work includes furnishing of labor, materials, and services for the construction of the following: upgrades to the existing treatment plant headworks, which include replacing the existing bar screens and grit separator and grit washer; addition of screenings washers and compactors; replacement of the headworks odor reduction tower; conversion of Solids Stabilization Basin 3 into a primary effluent equalization basin; addition of a primary effluent equalization basin pumping station; addition of a new trickling filter and associated recirculation pumping station; addition of aeration basins and aeration system including a Blower Building; addition of secondary sedimentation tanks; modifications to the existing secondary effluent pumping station; waste activated sludge thickening; digested sludge dewatering; a Solids Handling Building; miscellaneous yard piping; electrical duct bank; electrical systems; controls and instrumentation; a Locker and Shower Building; and other miscellaneous improvements to upgrade and facilitate the existing treatment plant process and operation to provide full secondary treatment.

TYPE OF BID

Bid shall be on a firm lump sum basis for the total of the items listed in the Bid Form.

SUBSTITUTION OF SECURITIES

Pursuant to Public Contract Code Section 22300, the substitution of securities shall be permitted for any moneys withheld by the District to ensure performance under the contract.

PREBID CONFERENCE

A pre-bid conference will be held as described in Section 00100 - Instructions to Bidders.

CONTRACT TIME

The Contract Time is defined in Section 00700 - General Conditions, and specified in Section 00500 - Agreement.

QUALIFICATION OF BIDDERS

Requirements concerning the qualifications of BIDDERS are described in Section 00100 - Instructions to Bidders. The BIDDER must be registered California Contractors State License Board Class A. **Only prime contractors that have been pre-qualified by the District pursuant to Public Contract Code Section 20101 are eligible to submit a bid for this project.**

OWNER'S RIGHT TO REJECT BIDS

Goleta Sanitary District reserves the right to waive irregularities and to reject all bids.

FUNDING

Funding for the project will use a low interest loan from the State of California State Revolving fund program.

LABOR CODE

Pursuant to the provisions of Section 1720 et seq. of the Labor Code of California, the Director of Industrial

Relations for the State of California has ascertained the current general prevailing rate of wages for employer purposes, in Santa Barbara County, State of California. In accordance with California Labor Code section 1771, not less than the general prevailing rate of per diem wages for work of a similar character in Santa Barbara County and not less than the general prevailing rate of per diem wages for holiday work fixed as provided in the California Labor Code must be paid to all workers engaged on the project

In accordance with the California Labor Code Section 1773.2, copies of the applicable determinations of the Director are on file in the District Office and may be reviewed upon request.
